Introduction

The first Quantitative InfraRed Thermography Asian Conference, (QIRT-Asia 2015) will take place during July 6-10, 2015, Radisson Blu Hotel, Mahabalipuram, (near Chennai) India. Since 1992, the Quantitative Infrared Thermography (QIRT) conference is a biannual international forum which brings together specialists from industry and academia, who share an active interest in the latest developments of science, experimental practices and instrumentation, related to IR thermography. Previously QIRT conferences have been held in Paris (1992), Sorrento (1994), Stuttgart (1996), Lodz (1998), Reims (2000), Dubrovnik (2002), Brussels (2004), Padova (2006), Krakow (2008), Québec City (2010), Naples (2012) and Bordeaux (2014). With the growing interest in this field and the growing number of attendees particularly coming from Asian countries, the QIRT Council has started a sister conference series called QIRT Asia. The first Quantitative InfraRed Thermography Asian Conference, (QIRT-Asia 2015) will take place during July 6-10, 2015, Mahabalipuram, (near Chennai) India.

surface temperature of the object is mapped by detecting the IR radiation emitted by them. IRT started as a qualitative tool in electrical and process industry for condition monitoring. Advances in sensors, electronics, instrumentation including signal and image processing saw the transformation of this method to a quantitative one. Today IR imaging is one of those few NDE methods that has applications cutting across all industries, research and society, ranging from astronomy, military, medical, energy audit, surveillance, condition monitoring, materials characterization.


Striving to stimulate young researchers, the organizing committee will award the best conference contribution presented and authored only by students.


Striving to stimulate young researchers, the organizing committee will award the best oral and poster papers authored and presented by young researchers below the age of 35 years.

Abstracts Submission

The participants are invited to submit abstracts of about 250 word to the QIRT-Asia 2015 through Web Site by April 20, 2015, either for oral or poster presentation. The abstract should clearly indicate the objective and outcome of the study and authors are requested to propose the thematic section in which the paper should be included. A book of abstracts will be distributed at the conference.

Following acceptance notification, camera ready, full paper of 6-10 pages including color figures should be submitted to the QIRT-Asia 2015 web site by May 30th, 2015.

All submissions for oral or poster presentation will be handled electronically via the conference website.

Authors are requested to propose the thematic section in which the paper should be included.

Web-based Proceedings and possible publication in QIRT Journal

Presented papers (oral and posters) will be published online in the QIRT Open-Archives which can be found at the website: www.qirt.org A USB flash drive with all conference papers will be also distributed to the conference participants.

After the conference, the Scientific Committee will carry out a pre-selection of the most prominent presented papers for a possible publication in Quantitative InfraRed Thermography Journal after a subsequent review by two experts.


